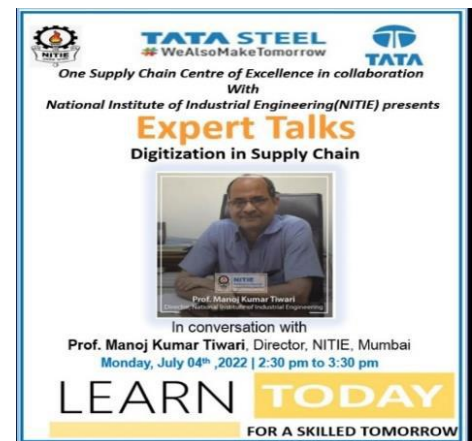


Expert Talk on Digitization in Supply Chain

The Talk was conducted by Prof. Manoj Tiwari (Director, NITIE).

Valedictory Ceremony of the General Management Programme for Defence Officers (DGMP) - Batch 02

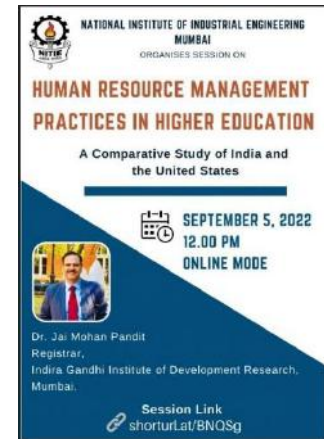

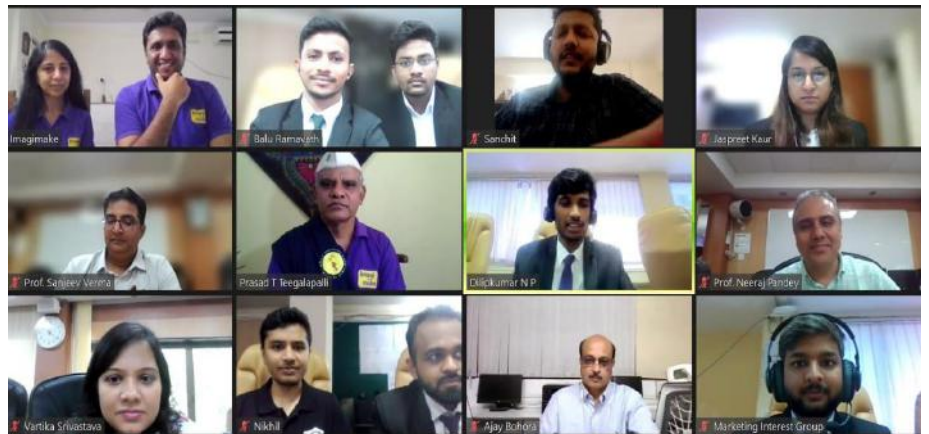
Student Focus

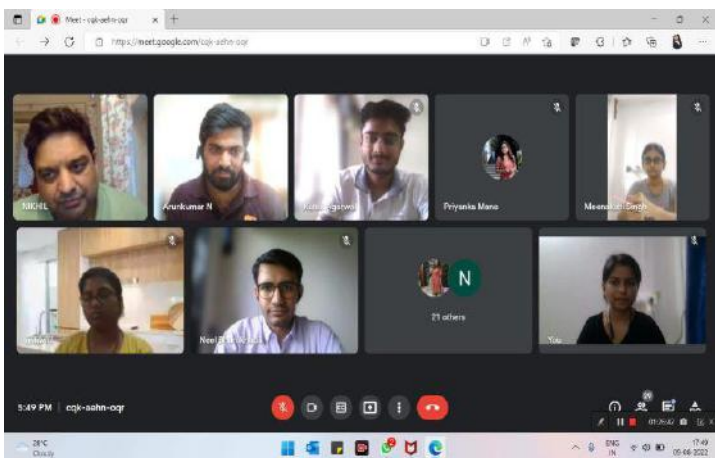

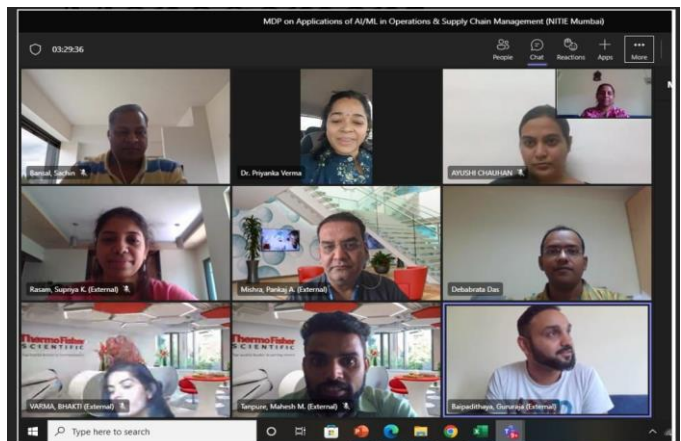


Applications of AI/ML in Supply Chain Management

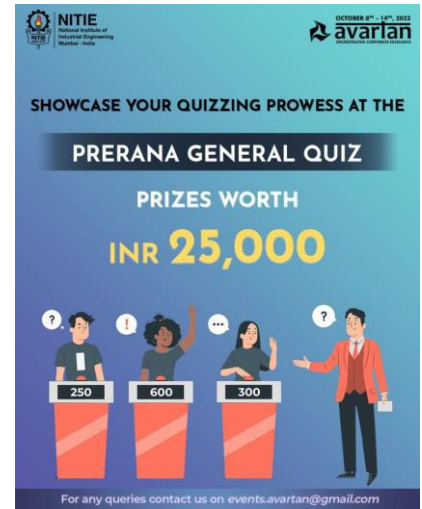


Prerana General Quiz Launched under Avartan'22
