



Nodal Hub for Gati Shakti Scheme

On 75th Anniversary of Indian Independence Day (Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav), Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji announced that the Centre will launch 'PM Gati Shakti Master Plan', a Rs. 100 lakh-crore projects for developing 'holistic infrastructure'. PM Gati Shakti was launched formally in October 2021. It is designed as a National Plan for Multi-modal Connectivity, essentially a digital platform to bring 16 Ministries, including Railways and Roadways, together for integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects. The PM Gati shakti program is based on 6 comprehensiveness, prioritization, optimization, synchronization, analytical, and dynamics.

Curriculum Review as per NEP

National Institute of Industrial Engineering has carried out a massive exercise of curriculum review as per the NEP 2020 spanning over six months under the visionary leadership of Director Prof. Manoj Tiwari involving multi-stakeholders including, industry experts, alumni, faculty members from leading institutes like Top IITs, IIMs, and international-universities.

The objective of the curriculum review was to carve out an industry-relevant and globally competitive curriculum. The process was divided into 3 stages. Initially, a sense-making exercise was carried out by consulting recruiters, industry experts, and passed out students. Then the NITIE faculty members prepared the syllabus according to the industry trends and expectations of the industry, alumni, and faculty members from other institutes. The same was then taken to topnotch academicians from IITs, IIMs, and international universities.

The new curriculum will be implemented from the academic session beginning in June 2022. The incoming students of NITIE will be immensely benefitted as the new curriculum is the right mix of technology, analytics, and management. In the new curriculum, NITIE students will be offered courses from world-renowned professors also. The new curriculum received many accolades from both industry and academia.



Workshop with the MOE

National Institute of Industrial Engineering Mumbai has successfully organized an online half-day workshop on 28th June 2022, in association with the Ministry of Education (MoE) and BISAG-N. The workshop was organized as a part of the celebrations of 75 years of Independence (Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav) under the PM Gati Shakti Mission.

NITIE Mumbai has been appointed as the Nodal Hub for capacity Building in Logistics and Supply Chain Management. The theme of the workshop was "Leveraging Satellite communication, Geo-informatics, and Geospatial technology for urban planning and to promote multimodal logistics". This workshop aims to promote capacity building in logistics and supply chains and provide insights on Geoinformatics and Geospatial Technology applications that facilitate integrated planning across multimodal transport.




Placements for PGDEx VLFM Batch of 2021-22

THE NATIONAL Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) is looking at a major infrastructural shift as it is heading toward IIM status. A plan is already in motion with projects like new hostels, staff quarters and renovation of old classrooms and lecture halls, strengthening of the boundary wall and beautification of the campus among all with funding under the HEFA (Higher Education Funding Agency).

The institute is spread across 63 acres of a forested hilltop near Lake in Powai in Mumbai's eastern suburbs. Upgradation of all old infrastructure, including all buildings, lighting, roads, boundary wall, and common areas is on a war footing. Internal and external renovation of all six hostels, cafeterias, 14 residential buildings and five office buildings will be covered under the upgradation plan.

The infrastructural development plan is expected to cost around Rs 160 crore. Out of which Rs 95.5 crore is already approved under the HEFA," shared Professor Manoj Tiwari, Director of the institute, adding that NITIE hopes for a positive response soon on its IIM status, as the committee formed to deliberate on the feasibility to bring NITIE under the IIM Act has submitted its report.
