NITIE Prerana Leadership Talk: General MM Naravane, Chief of the Army Staff

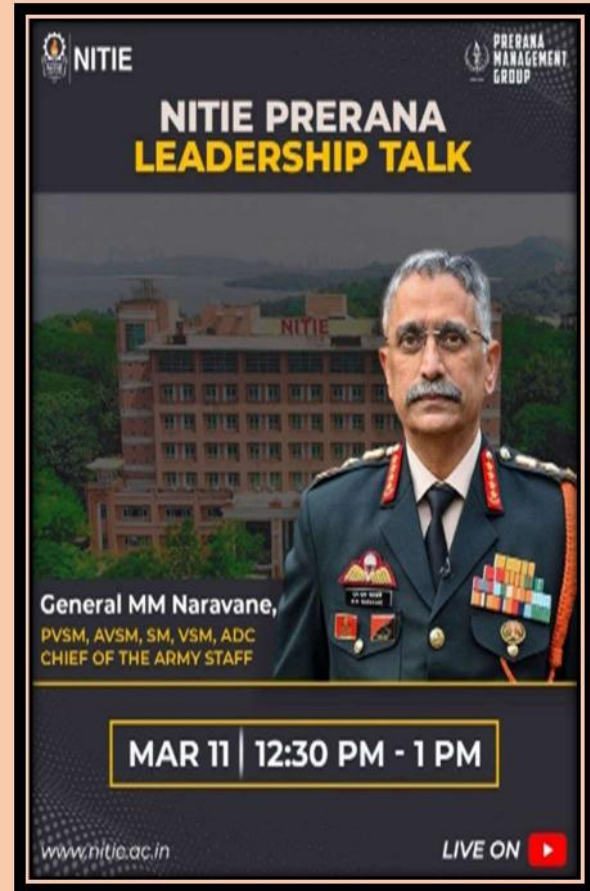
National Institute of Industrial Engineering Mumbai is honoured to host General Manoj Mukund Naravane, Chief of the Army Staff, as the guest of honour for the NITIE Prerana Leadership Talk. He has been awarded with the Param Vishisht Seva Medal, Ati Vishisht Seva Medal, Sena Medal, Vishisht Seva Medal and the CoAS commendation card for his exceptional service across his military career spanning over four decades.

General MM Naravane was commissioned into the 7th Battalion of the Sikh Light Infantry in June 1980. He has commanded the 2nd Battalion of Rashtriya Rifles in J&K, the Assam Rifles as Inspector General in Kohima, served in Counter-insurgency operations in J&K, Northeast India, and Indian Peace Keeping Force in Sri Lanka. The talk had encompassed glimpses from his experiences and his life-long journey, with the aim of inspiring the next generation of business leaders.

General MM Naravane, delivered a virtual address during Prerana Leadership Talk, organised by National Institute of Industrial Engineering Mumbai.

General MM Naravane said "No Nation can be great without the perseverance, belief, hard work and sacrifice of its youth."

He also said "the basic tenets of leadership in all walks of life are inter-related & are as relevant to the Corporate World as they are to the Defence Forces. What we need is strong leaders – men & women of Sterling Character, High Moral Values & Radiant Personalities."

E-Summit

MSME Conclave

NITIE E-Cell had organized the MSME Conclave under the umbrella of E-Summit, the annual event of Entrepreneurship Cell of NITIE Mumbai. The MSME Conclave was conducted in presence of Dr. Avinash Joshi, COO of SATHI Foundation, Mr. Raju Gundala, founder of MSMEonline.in and Mr. RAVI RANJAN, founder at Velocity1. Dr. Joshi shared his thoughts on SATHI Foundation (Sophisticated Analytical and Technical Help Institute) and how it is focused on Industrial Development in the country. For instance, the need to have a research-oriented culture in industries and amongst business professionals. Mr. Ranjan shared his thoughts on what is unique about start-ups, the different thinking processes, and about the fundamental objective of solving problems and they tried to scale the solutions. He also highlighted that Small Sector/MSMEs need hand-holding and promotion by the government and if they alter their thought process like a start-up the dependency on external help would decrease. Mr. Gundala threw light on the current scenarios of MSME in India, he pointed out Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal contribute to ~30% of MSME and shared his thoughts on the needs of the MSME sector.

The major points discussed were centered on challenges in implementation, the impact of the VUCA market, and the potential solutions. Later discussion followed on “Is support from Government enough & what the best way is? Centralized or decentralized” where the main point raised was of a Hybrid structure of support comprising centralization and decentralization at an adequate level. Also, the need for localization of support from the government as a policy designed at central may not reach a village. The final discussion was around “Requirement of Training Institute at school level and how it can help youth to get skilled?” The guests highlighted the efforts of various state governments in this direction and how it is impacting Industries and entrepreneurs.

Team E-Cell has hosted its proud alumni, Mr. Sandeep Nailwal, co-founder of Polygon Technology, and Mrs. Harshita Singh, Co-founder of Timeswap Labs, in event Empresario, an endeavor to spread the wave-‘Entrepreneurship everywhere’. This year, Entrepreneurship Cell, through E-Summit 2022 conferred the crown of Empresario to Mr. Sandip Nailwal. A proud alumnus of NITIE, Sandip, shared his entrepreneurial journey and provided his valuable insights with all of us. He talked about the importance of Web3.0, decentralizing institutions where the whole community owns the decision-making. He spoke about India which has become a force globally to reckon with now. He highlighted the importance of ‘Game Theory’ and ‘Network Analysis’ in today’s evolving world. 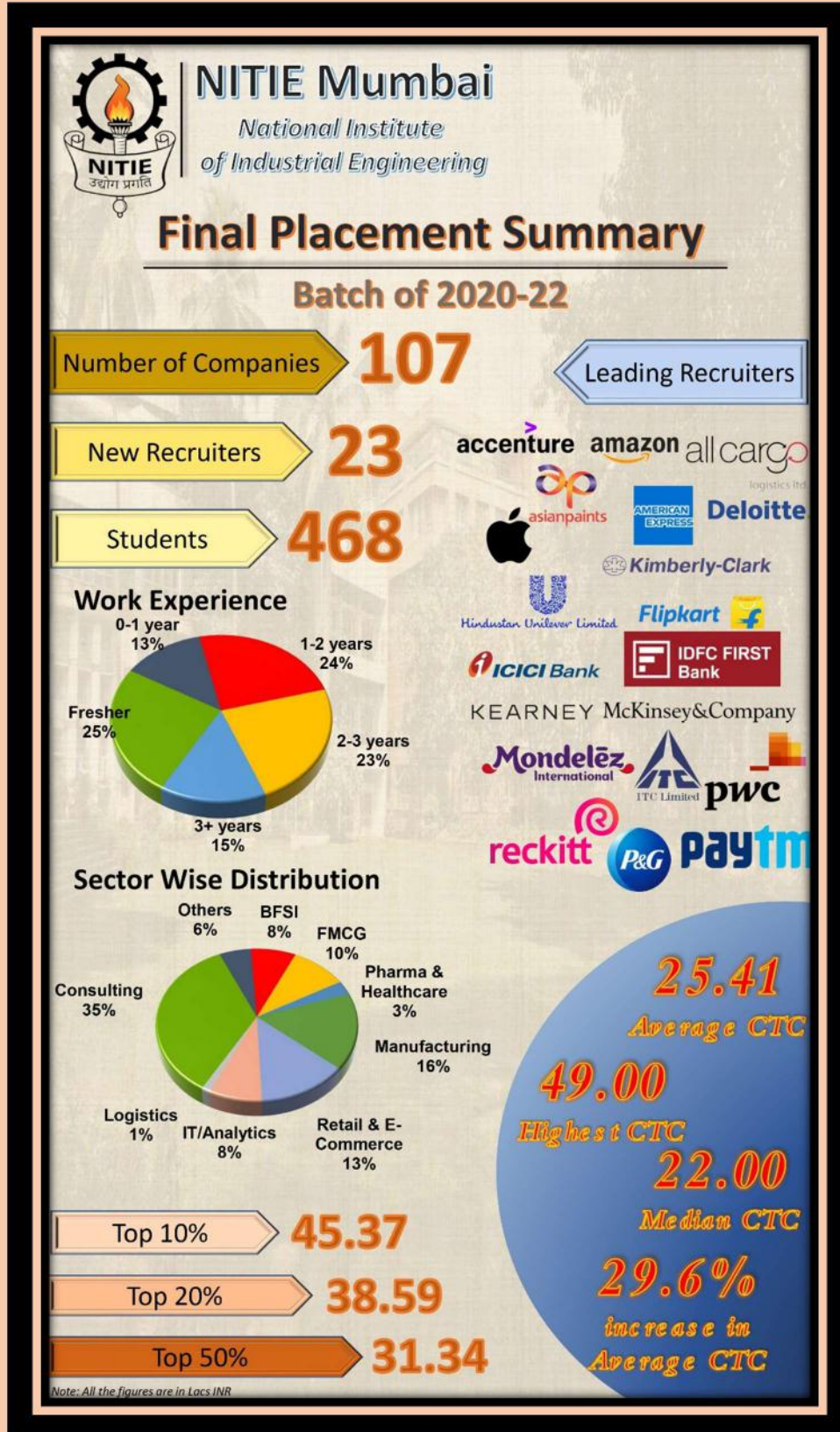

Samiksha - Panel Discussion

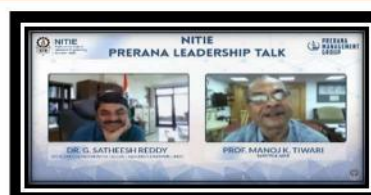

Mum could get own IIM in NITIE, edu min panel to study feasibility

Mumbai: Mumbai could soon have its own IIM. The Union ministry of education has set up a committee to study the feasibility of bringing Pwani's National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) under the IIM Act, 2007.

If all goes well, NITIE will join the elite club of IIMs - second in the state after Nagpur. NITIE has been a contributor in imparting education in industrial engineering, engineering management and management sciences. Now, it aspires to come under the IIM Act, mentioned a ministry memorandum constituting the committee.

Ashishkumar Chauhan, MD & CEO of Bombay Stock Exchange will be chairman of the committee, while directors of IIM Tiruchirappalli, IIT Bombay (director: Subhasis Chaudhuri) and IITRRI and an industry person will be its members.

The committee will assess the institute's preparedness for its inclusion under the IIM Act. It will examine if it has the adequate infrastructure and staff, its future roadmap and the financial implications of such a decision, among other things. The committee is expected to submit the report within a month.

NITIE was set up in 1963, after the first two IIMs in Kolkata and Ahmedabad and was equally popular in those days, said Manoj Tiwari, director of the institute. It, though, was registered under the Societies Registration Act of 1860 and was not a degree awarding institute like the IIMs. "It was attracting the best talent from the country but could only award post-graduate diplomas, certificates and fellowships. As other IIMs were set up, students started opting for them. We are still the industry best in operations and supply chain management and now we want to move to another level," said Tiwari.

Though the process may take long, the institute is confident about positioning itself as an IIM and hopes to be included under the Act.

Tiwari said the city gives scope for attracting the best faculty for a premier institute such as IIM. The institute is keen on offering newer programmes in management, in line with the National Education Policy.

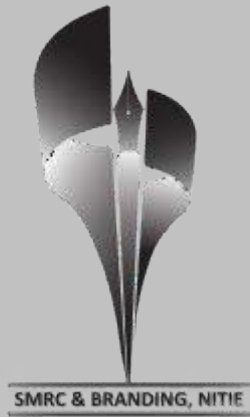
