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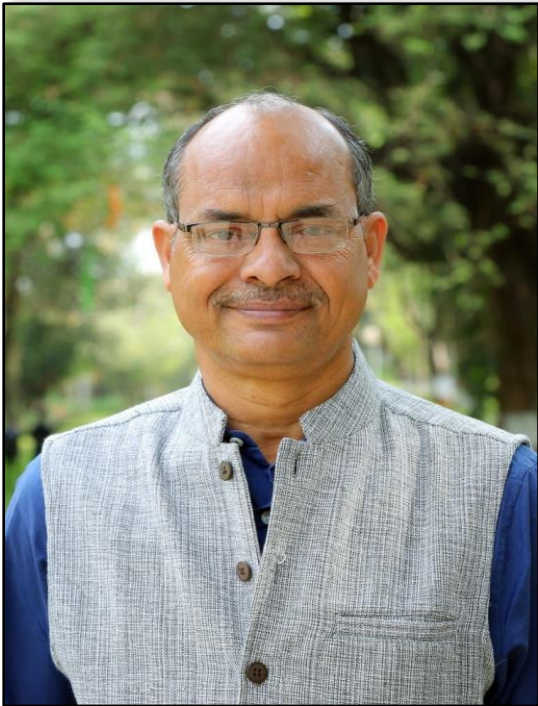
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Director's Message

The centre was inaugurated by Shri Piyush Goyal, Honourable Minister of Commerce & Industry, the function was also graced by Chairman, NITIE Board of Governor, Mr Shashi Kiran Shetty. Prof. Manoj Kumar Tiwari, Director NITIE welcomed the guests and delivered the inaugural address. NITIE ranked 12th in the Management category of NIRF 2021 Rankings

National Institute Ranking Framework or NIRF is the first-ever effort by the government to rank higher education institutions (HEIs) in the country. We are very happy to announce that NITIE has performed exceedingly well across different parameters and has been ranked 12th in the Management category of NIRF 2021 Rankings.

NITIE's activities in academics, industry connect, and social front with a very active presence on social media has enabled us to improve the perception parameter scores by 77% compared to our last year's scores.

In the research and Professional Practice parameter, due to the focus on quality research, we have a 13.8 percent improvement compared to our 2020 scores. We have also improved in the Graduation outcomes this year as many new companies came for recruitment this year. This year we have marginally improved inclusivity and outreach, and the overall percentile score has also improved.

NITIE Ranked in the top 100 in SDG Goal 8

NITIE has been a thought leader in Industrial Engineering education and research and is an active partner in the Nation's manufacturing renaissance. We have also been a forerunner in Sustainability, and we started a Postgraduate Programme in Industrial Safety and Environmental Management as early as 2001.

The Times Higher Education [THE] had started impact ranking in recent years. These are based on the 17 sustainable development goals (SDGs) of the UN, which must be achieved by 2030. NITIE had participated in four goals for THE Impact rankings 2021. These Goals are Goal one on No Poverty, SDG 6 on clean water and sanitation, SDG 8 on Decent Work and Economic growth, and SDG 17 on Partnership for the SDG goals

We are happy to announce that NITIE has achieved the 68th rank in the world in Goal number 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth with a score of 71.6 out of 100. Goal eight is a very significant goal for our Nation as it focuses on promoting Sustainability and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment, and decent work for all. We are indeed happy that NITIE has scored almost 100 percent on the parameters like expenditure for employees and percentage of students in work placement.

NITIE also scored well in Goal 6, which is on Clean Water and Sanitation. We have done well in water usage and care parameter. NITIE is committed to performing even better in the coming years on these Sustainable Development Goals.

The Ranking Team comprising of Prof Vijaya Gupta, Prof Seema Unnikrishnan, Prof Padmanava Acharya, Prof Rakesh Raut, and Prof Ravindra Gokhale, under the guidance of Prof M K Tiwari, Director NITIE, have taken up 6 SDGs to participate in THE Impact Ranking this year.

NITIE will be conducting six batches of Executive Development Program over the next one year. NITIE Faculty will train L&T participants across various functional domains of management and leadership. Further, NITIE and L&T also discussed on exploring the options to strengthen the collaboration through other Industry outreach activities.

The students will have access to real world use cases leveraging specialized software in the respective domain areas as a part of the curriculum, as well as internship and sponsored projects.

The courses will be jointly handled by experts drawn from NITIE, industry and Genpact, making it a perfect blend of academic proficiency and practical experience. The Centre aims to focus on Digital Twin, Digital Thread, Analytics and LEAN deployment in Manufacturing and supply chain.

As a part of MoU, Genpact will be funding two women chair professors to promote and support diversity, especially in manufacturing, logistics, and supply chain analytics and establish scholarships for six women students to encourage women in STEM and build diverse leaders in supply chain.

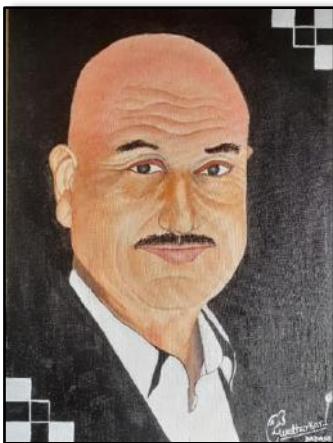

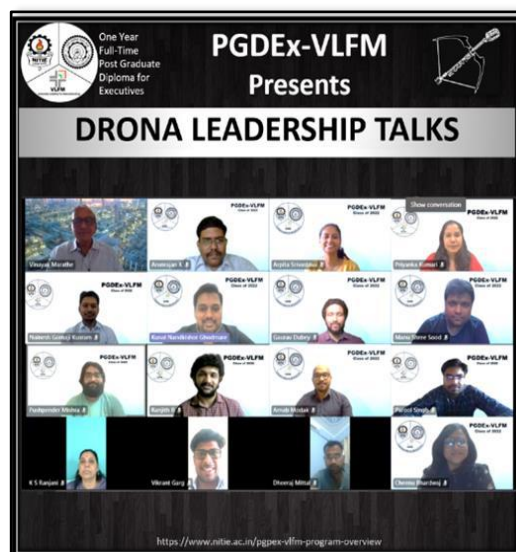
In the competition, the mentor-mentee pairs came up with many creative ways to transform waste like Plastic, CDs, and textile into useful products.

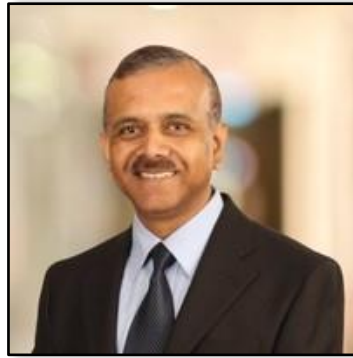
