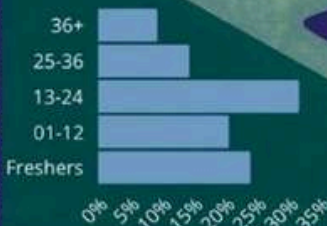

# 1,013 students awarded degrees at first convocation of IIM Mumbai

THE INDIAN Institute of Management (IIM) Mumbai held its first convocation on Saturday where a total of 1,013 students were awarded degrees, including two batches 2020-2022 and 2021-23.

These students have become the first ones to get their degree certificate under the IIM Mumbai stamp, which was erstwhile National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE). At the same time, these two

batches are also the last ones to get Post Graduate (PG) Diploma which NITIE offered until now. Batches passing out of IIM Mumbai hereafter will get IIM Mumbai's MBA degree.

Among the 1,013 students, there were 32 PhD candidates. From batches 2020-2022 and 2021-2023 there were 482 and 531 students, respectively.

Congratulating the students, Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, who was the chief guest for the event, said, "The institute has travelled a long distance in its journey to become IIM. I am glad to know that

it has seen a 20 per cent jump in the number of recruiters coming for placements indicating changing market perception post the new status. But I will encourage students of IIM Mumbai to become entrepreneurs instead and give jobs." Stating that the IIM ecosystem contributes to India's wealth management, Pradhan urged the newest and 21st IIM of India to work toward building unicorns.

Ashishkumar Chauhan, MD & CEO, National Stock Exchange (NSE), was guest of honour for the event. Among others present for the first convocation of IIM

Mumbai were Chairman, Board of Governors (BOG) of IIM Mumbai, Shashi Kiran Shetty and Director of IIM Mumbai Prof. Manoj Kumar Tiwari, along with all faculty members, students and parents.

Established in 1963 as NITIE, the institute is known for its expertise in logistics and supply chain management. In August 2023, the institute gained the status of IIM Mumbai, following the latest amendment to the IIM Act.

आईआईएम मुंबई के प्रथम दीक्षांत समारोह में बोले केंद्रीय शिक्षा मंत्री

समय आ गया है कि प्रबंधन संस्थानों से पास होने वाले विद्यार्थी अब नौकरी खोजने के बजाय दूसरों को रोजगार देने वाले काम शुरू करें। केंद्रीय शिक्षा मंत्री धर्मेंद्र प्रधान ने भारतीय प्रबंधन संस्थान मुंबई के पहले दीक्षांत समारोह में यह बात कही। उन्होंने कहा कि साल 2014 से पहले देश में 350 ही स्टार्टअप थे, लेकिन पिछले 10 वर्षों में इनकी संख्या 1 लाख से ज्यादा हो गई है। इनमें से 108 स्टार्टअप युनिवर्सिटी बन चुके हैं और देश की अर्थव्यवस्था में नए उद्योगपतियों का योगदान 340 बिलियन से ज्यादा हो गया है। उन्होंने कहा कि हमें अपने कुछ वर्षों में एक हजार से ज्यादा युनिवर्सिटी बनाने हैं, जिनमें से कम से कम 25 नए आईआईएम मुंबई से होने चाहिए। प्रधान ने कहा कि 2047 तक विश्वीय भारत बनाने में शिक्षा और तकनीक का अग्रणी योगदान होगा। अनुसंधान में भारत दुनिया की तीसरी सबसे बड़ी अर्थव्यवस्था बन सकता है और यह युवाओं के लिए सबसे बेहतरीन समय है। उन्होंने कहा कि पहले मान्य जाह

# Two NITIE batches pass out as first IIM Mumbai graduates

Mumbai: Two batches of students who cleared common admission test (CAT) and joined National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE) in 2021 and 2022 passed out as graduates of IIM Mumbai on Saturday. The institute had put on hold the convocation process for the class of 2023, too, and institute director Manoj Kumar Tiwari lauded the students for their "patience" which had paid off.

For the record, both houses of Parliament gave their nod to the IIM (Amendment) 2023 bill and NITIE was converted to IIM Mumbai in August 2023. Several years and many proposals later, Centre in July this year approved the conversion of NITIE, a management institute only for engineers in Powai, to IIM Mumbai, an MBA-awarding institution open for all.

"This institute is over 60 years. We are celebrating its first convocation; this is its uniqueness. It defies all logic that Mumbai did not have an IIM," said Dharmendra Pradhan, education minister. Reminding everyone how the Prime Minister has rebranded the 'Gen Z' as Amrit Pedhi, he said this generation is the catalyst of socio-economic change and has the responsibility to be solution providers for global and societal issues for the next 25 years. Pradhan emphasised the youth must not be merely job seekers, but strive to be job providers. Pradhan unveiled the new logo of IIM Mumbai and Vivekaramda Hall Phase 2 of the institute. A total of 31 fellow and PhDs graduated on Saturday, highest ever for this institute. Recently, the number of IIM board members were reduced from 22 to 18. A total of 1,013 students received degrees on Saturday, including 865 for post-graduate programmes.

# Neighbours need each other: EAM amid strained ties with Maldives

AMID THE recent tension with Maldives after three ministers in that country's government posted objectionable comments on social media against Prime Minister Narendra Modi even as an 'India Out' campaign has been unfolding in the island nation, External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar said, "At the end of the day, neighbours need each other."

Speaking at the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Mumbai on Tuesday on 'India's role in the global stage' and on his recently published book 'Why Bharat Matters', Jaishankar said, "Every country has problems in the neighbourhood... eventually they reach an understanding... It is in the nature of politics that we take strong stands, but diplomacy works differently."

Addressing a question on the crisis in the Red Sea, Jaishankar said that the Indian Navy has deployed 10 ships in that region.

Sharing how INS Visakhapatnam extinguished a fire onboard a commercial oil tanker, the Union minister added that the Indian Navy rescued Pakistani and Iranian fishermen. "We will not be considered a responsible country when bad things are happening in the surrounding country and we say 'I have got nothing to do with this,'" he said.

Jaishankar spoke about how his new book connects various

diplomacy lessons with the Ramayana and urged the youth to take an interest in foreign policy. "In today's globalised world, foreign policy matters to all of you," he said.

When a student asked how an MBA-degree holder can really matter when it comes to foreign policy, Jaishankar said, "A large part of how the international economy will work is on how you build connections, businesses, logistics and supply chain

management — how they work in real life, which is the forte of your institute."

He also spoke about how the perception of India in the world is based on their experiences. Sharing how Indians heading global tech giants, banks etc will make the world think about it, he said, "Branding of the country is really important in geopolitics and networking."

Talking about the Israel-Gaza situation, the minister said, "What happened on October 7 was a terrorist attack (by Hamas against Israel). As a country which has experienced so much terrorism, it is important that we recognise and accept it."

Adding that there are various aspects to this crisis and a viable solution should be found, Jaishankar also acknowledged the civilian casualties and said, "There has to be a sustainable humanitarian corridor."

Speaking about the common victim bonding among colonised countries in the global south, he said that India is looked at as one of these countries that shows strong development.

# 'Dealing with double problem in Red Sea'

MUMBAI: "We shouldn't fear Beijing. We must welcome competition and try to be better than them," said S Jaishankar, external affairs minister, during an interaction with students at the Indian Institute of Management Mumbai on Tuesday. Admitting that China is among the world's major economies, Jaishankar said Delhi should not fear Beijing's tactics and focus on giving its best and strengthening diplomatic ties with other South Asian countries.

"It is India's neighbour and is going to deploy resources and shape South Asia's geopolitical situation in China's way," Jaishankar said while responding to a students' question pointing out China's continuous efforts to strengthen its ties with nations like Bangladesh, Maldives, and Pakistan. Jaishankar emphasised the need to help neighbouring countries during difficult situations. "We are the first country who helped Sri Lanka in its crisis," he said. He further emphasised that rather than complaining about what China is doing, he said India's response is, "Let me do better than that."

The event, "In Conversation with Dr S Jaishankar" moderated by author Vijay Chauthaiwale, the diplomat-turned-politician touched upon the Red Sea crisis and India's Neighbourhood First policy. The Red Sea, a vital conduit for East-West trade, is witnessing persistent disruptions due to the Yemeni Houthi militia's attacks on ships, causing a significant uptick in fuel and interest costs, longer voyages and straining the capacities of the logistics sector. He spoke about the Indian Navy's deployment of warships in the Red Sea region to deal with attacks on merchant navy vessels. "We did it because we have a double prob-

MUMBAI: To enhance campus accessibility, IIM Mumbai has approached the BMC for an elevated road from the Sakhi Vihar Road junction. Sources from the institute said that in a letter sent to BMC, the institute emphasised having improved connectivity on Vihar Lake Road.
