The National Institute of Training in Industrial Engineering was likely to be started in 1963 or 1964, said Prof. Humayun Kabir, Minister of Scientific Research and Cultural Affairs.

Mr. Kabir said a 35-acre site had been secured in Bombay and a board of governors set up for the management of the institute.

GENESIS



On the 22nd of June, 1962, an unassuming snippet in The Indian Express heralded the dawn of an idea. The National Institute of Training in Industrial Engineering was to shape the lives and minds of pioneers who would drive a country still in its infancy.

Shortly over two months later, on the 30th of August, 1962, the first Board of Governors convened, a star-studded congregation of illuminaries from the subcontinent - Shri. Y B Chavan, Shri. Vikram Sarabhai, Shri. S L Kirloskar, Shri S Moolgaokar among them.

A gamechanger was in the works.

Industrial engg. training institute

NEW DELHI, Dec. 8 (PTI).

A national institute for training in industrial engineering is expected to start functioning at Powai, Bombay, from January.

The institute, which will be located near the Indian Institute of Technology at Powai, will train persons from industry, Government departments and other organisations in industrial engineering and allied subjects.

The courses, numbering 31 dealing with various aspects of industrial engineering, will range from 8 to 22 weeks.

The institute will have a training capacity of over 1,400 technicians a year after it starts functioning fully.

Noted industrialist Anand Mahindra and HDFC chairman Deepak Parekh have suggested the upgrade of Powai-based National Institute of Technical and Industrial Engineering (Nitie) to the status of an IIM. Following up their demand for an IIM for Mumbai, they felt conversion of Nitie would save both time and money and India's financial capital can boast of an IIM sooner than later.

The duo - two of India's corporate honchos and leading members of the 'Citizens' Action Group' - met the Prime Minister Dr Manmohan Singh with

their suggestion. "For long, the students of Nitie have been petitioning for the status of IIM, for which they also ran a signature campaign for the same," said Mahindra. Incidentally an

ex-director of Nitie. He told DNA that the institute has good infrastructure as well as funds. "Also, its proximity to the Indian Institute of Technology campus is also an advantage," added Mahindra. It is learnt that Singh has promised to look into the issue.

Our former chairman, **Shri Anand Mahindra** expressed the sentiment as early and sowed the first seed of change as early as 2007, and in 2022, the IIM rebirth was in its embryonic stage. With Education Ministry Secretary **Sanjay Murthy's** unwavering support of our cause, a historical effort was put into effect. **BSE's Ashishkumar Chauhan** headed the expert panel that was to bring NITIE under the IIM Act, that also included **Pramod Kumar Jain**, Director at IIT, BHU; **Pawan Kumar Singh**, Director at IIM, Tiruchirappalli; **Subhasis Choudhuri**, Director at IIT, Bombay and **Pradeep Goyal**, CMD at Pradeep Metals.

New Delhi, the 11th August, 2023/Sravana 20, 1945 (Saka)

The following Act of Parliament received the assent of the President on the 11th August, 2023 and is hereby published for general information:—

THE INDIAN INSTITUTES OF MANAGEMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2023
No. 23 of 2023 [11th August, 2023.]

An Act further to amend the Indian Institutes of Management Act, 2017.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Institutes of Management (Amendment) Act, 2023. (Short title and commencement.)
(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. In section 4 of the Indian Institutes of Management Act, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), after sub-section (1), the following sub-section shall be inserted, namely:— (Amendment of section 4.)

“(1A) On and from the date of commencement of the Indian Institutes of Management (Amendment) Act, 2023, the National Institute of Industrial Engineering, Mumbai, shall be called the “Indian Institute of Management, Mumbai” and all the provisions of this Act shall apply to the said Institute.”

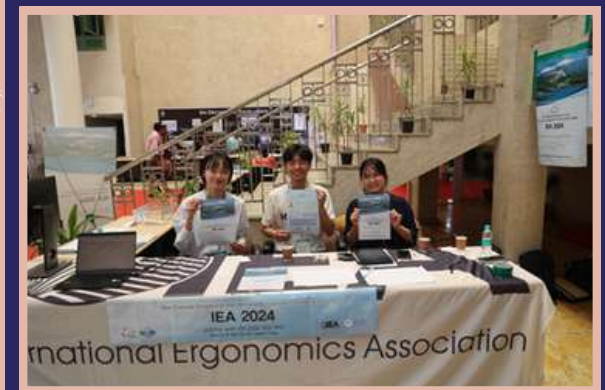

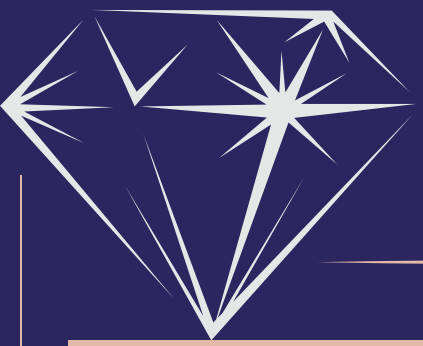

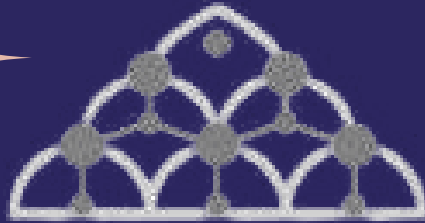
