This notice refers to the advertisement cited above. Interested candidates and applicants wishing to apply in the area of Public Policy are requested to read the following information before applying.

(a) System Dynamics and Policy Modelling (one position):

System thinking and system dynamics are central to understanding complex policy problems, their feedback effects and the long-term impact of interventions. The Centre for Policy and Governance (CPG) at IIM Mumbai seeks to engage a suitable resource to develop simulation models using AnyLogic or other suitable software. The resource will also prepare policy use cases, illustrative examples, case studies and teaching material in support of the Centre's academic, research and training activities. Candidates should hold at least a Bachelor's degree in Engineering or Science and have adequate knowledge of simulation and model building. Additional experience or courses in system dynamics, simulation software or policy modelling will be given due weightage.

(b) Other Areas of Public Policy:

The remaining positions under Public Policy are open to candidates with research interest in any area of public policy and governance. Indicative areas include:

- public finance and economic policy
- urban and infrastructure development
- energy, environment and climate policy
- health, education and social sector policy
- digital governance and technology policy
- agriculture and rural development
- national security and strategic affairs
- regulatory and institutional reforms

Candidates will be expected to undertake policy research, prepare policy briefs, case studies and teaching material, and support the Centre's research projects, training programmes and engagements with government and other stakeholders. Candidates with published policy research, field experience, or experience of working with government bodies, think tanks or development organisations will be given due weightage.

Applicants are required to submit the documents mentioned in the advertisement referred to above to admin.fa@iimmumbai.ac.in, along with the following. The subject line should read "Public Policy (CPG) – System Dynamics" or "Public Policy (CPG) – [Area of Interest]", as applicable.

1. A statement of interest (not exceeding 500 words) indicating the position applied for and describing the applicant's interest and proposed work in the chosen area.
2. For the System Dynamics position: samples of, or links to, simulation models or projects developed by the applicant, if any. For other areas: a research proposal (not exceeding 1,000 words) or a writing sample, such as a policy brief, paper or report.
3. Certificates of relevant courses, training or software proficiency (e.g., AnyLogic, Vensim, Stella), if any.
4. Experience certificates, if any.

All other terms and conditions remain as stated in the advertisement referred to above.
