Indian Institute of Management Mumbai Invites Applications for the post of Professor of Practice (on Contract) from exceptionally experienced and accomplished Industry, and Management professionals in respective domain area with excellent track record to be a part of fast-growing management institute in the form of Professors of Practice. in following areas:

Individuals, with an outstanding track record of success in senior leadership positions from private or public organisations are eligible for this category, who have proven records of having demonstrated professional excellence and leadership in management or a closely related field, normally through distinguished service in senior-level positions over an extended period. This position entails an initial one-year appointment, renewable based on the performance of the individual and requirement of the Institute, up to a maximum of 3 years from the date of initial engagement.

Professor of Practice, like other Faculty members are permitted to pursue industry consulting with income sharing with the Institute as per the Institute's policy. Additional compensation for outreach activities may be considered subject to fulfilling the Institute norms.

The Professors of Practice are expected to facilitate innovative teaching and learning tools, practice-oriented pedagogies by promoting creativity, and innovation, and teach in different programs as per the norms of the Institute. Professors of Practice are also expected to promote industry-institute linkages through a wide range of activities, including participation in executive education, supporting various centres and programmes, resource generation and consulting

assignments / MDPs and involve in placement and academics activities. She/he will also be expected to identify industry needs, and coordinate and develop cutting edge courses to be

conducted by IIM Mumbai.

Professors of Practice may be hired as full time Chair Professor of Practice as per Institute policy.

The selected candidate may be offered a position of 'Professor of Practice Grade I' or 'Professor

of Practice Grade II' depending on the experience and qualification.

Eligibility Criteria:

Master's Degree (preferably MBA) or equivalent professional qualification from a reputed

national or international institution. (Candidates with non-business degrees such as master's

degree in finance, Accounts, Chartered Accountant etc. would also be considered).

Minimum 15 years of managerial or professional experience out of which at least 5 years at

senior management position is mandatory.

Must have significant potential to develop industry/government/international connect and

ability to leverage the same for the benefit of the Institute.

They may help bring research and consulting projects, serving as a liaison between the

Institute and the industry or government entities to identify research.

While a Ph.D. is desirable, it is not essential. However, a lack of Ph.D. must be offset by

demonstrated domain knowledge, obtained from the field.

Remuneration:

Gross emoluments inclusive of HRA will be fixed on consolidated basis. This will be decided after

the interview, and will be based on the profile of the individual:

Professor of Practice Grade I: Rs. 1.50L to Rs.2.00L (inclusive of all) i.

ii. Professor of Practice Grade II: Rs.1.10L to Rs.1.70L (inclusive of all)

Duration and nature of engagement:

This is a contractual appointment for a period of one year, renewable every year based on

performance, up to a maximum of 3 years. They may be considered for extension of contract for a

further period of three years based on rigorous evaluation of their performance.
